Old Business

Regional Committee Member Reports

BLASCNA- The BLASCA area is doing well and surviving on group 7th tradition donations. We currently have 28 meetings in Lucas County and 2 in Fulton County. Two meetings continue as hybrid, live and on Zoom. One new meeting has been added to our meeting directory in the last three month.

I was able to get a quarterly regional donation from the treasurer for \$300.00, and a \$200.00 donation to OCNA 42. Currently the ASC bank balance as of April 3rd was \$9416.00. Our ASC balance increased due to TACNA 26 being a success.

COASCNA- No one present/ No report

DASCNA- The geographical areas are Montgomery and Greene Counties. We currently have 39 groups in our meeting schedule. We have 9 H&I commitments currently. At our last area meeting 13 groups were represented. In the past 3 months no meetings folded and 2 new GSR came to area meetings.

FRASCNA- No one present/ No report

GCASCNA- The Greater Cincinnati Area continues to focus on serving the fellowship through a stable network of 61 groups that host 82 meetings every week. Financially, the area experienced a negative cash flow of \$619.39 for the February period. While our total income reached \$1,346.05—largely through \$880.90 in literature sales and \$465.15 in group donations—total expenses for the month were \$1,965.44. Major expenditures included significant literature purchases for the area and H&I, alongside travel reimbursements for RCM service. Despite this monthly deficit, the area maintains a healthy ending bank balance of \$4,539.23 as of February 28, 2026.

HAMASCNA- Is currently serving Butler and Warren counties. We currently have 17 meetings a week. They have about 8-10 GSR's showing up at each area. They have established a zoom link for use for committee meetings as well as for area meetings, which is doing very well.

KORASCNA- 18 meetings between 13 groups in Portsmouth, New Boston, Lucasville, and Ironton. There has been a new meeting that has been added to our area and its from the Ironton area and they are actively seeking guidance and support to establish meetings that follow traditions.

MOASCNA- The geographic area MOASCNA includes Marion, Fostoria, Tiffin, Bucyrus and Findlay. The are currently has 9 groups, 16 meetings, and 2 H&I panels. No new groups added but we have had two groups fold in our area.

MVASCNA- Our area serves Miami, Shelby, and Darke counties. We currently have 16 groups with 20 meetings and 1 H&I panel.

PUASCNA- No one Present/ No report

SASCNA- Clarke and Champaign counties, 13 groups hosting 17 meetings with 2 H&I commitments. The area continues to do well overall. The meeting attendance remains consistent, and the participation remains steady across the area.

SBASCNA-The geographic area served by the Sandusky Bay Area is Erie, Huron, Ottawa, Richland, and Sandusky. Our area presently has nine groups, thirteen meetings with no new meetings and no meetings closing.

SOVASCNA- The geographic area served by the Southern Ohio Valley area is Highland, Adams, Brown, and Claremont counties. Our area presently has 8 groups with about 15 meeting and 1 H&I panel. No new groups in the area but one has folded.

STASCNA- is the Stark, Tuscarawas, Carroll, Wayne, and Summit counties. We have 14 groups with 14 meeting and 1 virtual meeting weekly, also there are 3 H&I presentations. During the last cycle we lost another meeting.

SVASCNA- The geographic area served by Ross, Fayette, and Pike counties. We have 11 meetings with 3 H&I commitments

Regional Committee Reports

H & I Chair- We are currently working in collaboration with Chillicothe Correctional Institution to host a speaker jam recovery event. We are excited about this opportunity to carry the message of recovery and bring hope into the facility. Planning is underway, and we are looking forward to what we believe will be a meaningful and impactful event for everyone involved. More updates will be provided as we move forward in the planning. So far, we have the willingness from Paul H. and Megan from Central Ohio to share their experience, strength, and hope. We hope to add a couple other members to the event. We will be purchasing some literature to hand out and have a Q&A scheduled following the event. I would also appreciate any updated contact information of our Area H&I chairpersons. We will continue to keep you informed as things progress.

Outreach Chair- It impresses me how narcotics anonymous in Ohio region is growing and with a great sense of unity! For example, Athens, who is absorbed by the MEASCNA area and has had a meeting, standing strong and about to add another meeting to the schedule. Really encourages me cities like lima and surrounding area are still holding meetings and their unity maybe start the northwest area again. And finally, Finley; are hosing City today. Has signed up with MOASCNA and being a part of Ohio region. Our last regional meeting, I was handed a list of a few meetings that may

be struggling, and of course, my intent is always to be able to show up and to be of service for them, and I did not make it to any, which I'll try to do better this quarter. So please feel free to send me more meetings. I should be able to attend over the next quarter.

Phoneline Coordinator-The lack of communication with Townhall has been concerning this quarter. We received invoices and reports regarding calls to our hopeline for January and February, but not for March. In addition, I have sent multiple emails to Townhall to inquire about a new contract for calendar year 2026 but have gotten no response. I even sent them a copy of the contract we signed for calendar year 2025, so they had a reference point. It seems we are not alone in the lack of communication from Townhall. I read through some of the recent minutes posted on the Buckeye Region's website, and learned they have placed several unanswered calls to Townhall. With that in mind, I offer the following partial report. During the first two months of 2026, we received a total of 90 calls. As usual, the vast majority were categorized as "other" calls. Of those associated with Areas, the top three were COASCNA, Greater Cincinnati, and the Stark, Tusc, Carroll Area. While I find Townhall's inconsistency troubling, I'm not sure what more we can do about it. My opinion is that we are moving in the correct direction to develop an alternative. We may be wise to expedite that process as much as is possible.

Policy Coordinator- Pursuant to the passage of motion #2025:019 that was passed by this body at our last quarterly RSC meeting regarding reimbursement of regional funds by the RSC Treasurer, the language in Policy Section 4.3.1 now reads:
" The Region shall reimburse either the Host Area or the selected venue of the regional meeting up to \$300 a day." Last month I did a thorough review of our Region's Policy, and I believe that a fully updated version of Regional Policy is now posted on the Region's website. In conducting that review, I did notice that PUASCNA (the Phoenix United Area) is not included in the rotation of potential hosting Areas for OCNA (the Ohio NA Convention). I'm not sure if this was intentional (perhaps requested by that Area) or an oversight.

Public Relations Chair- I have nothing to report. There has been no activity in the Public Relations Ohio Region.

Webmaster- This has been a fairly slow quarter for web-related stuff, but pretty busy for me in other areas. I haven't started work on either Google Voice or Yap yet to replace our phoneline system. I have talked with 3 other regions about which way would be best, but still haven't made a decision on which one to implement. Both have their positives as well as some serious negatives.

12 Step Retreat (Fall)- I am happy to serve this year as the chair person for the Fall Tar Hollow 12 Step Retreat this year. I have a full committee besides the position of Secretary. If you have anyone willing to step into this role, please have them contact April D. I am also bringing a donation of \$3,733.09 Fromm last years retreat.

Traditions Retreat (Spring)- I am excited to announce that our fundraiser went well bringing in \$1,900.50 to help us start off with a bang! Hoodie pre-sale also went well, and the registrations keeps rolling in! Also happy to announce that the main entrance will be reopened in time for the retreat! No confusing back roads this year! Our whole committee is excited to be of service and can't wait for the event!

Convention- No one present/ No report

OCNA Advisor Committee- Things are well on their way with OCNA 42. I've asked to be added to their email DL and have yet to be added, but I did get with Barry the OCNA AC from the Buckeye region and he provided me with their meeting minutes from the February and March meetings. I will also be forwarding the most recent OCNA meeting minutes to our secretary. The convention needs more support, especially through registration and hotel bookings. I will also be trying to get them in contact with next year OCNA 43 chair and committee to coordinate the "hand-off" as well as seeing if OCNA 43 can help push registrations.

RD/RCM Meeting

So during the meeting Marvin H. Has some health issues that has impacted him to where he is unable to fill his duties as the Regional Delegate. He submitted a request to resign from his position for medical reason. Kirby who is the RDA has been nominated for the RD position. Dave L. who is the Policy Coordinator has resigned from his position to become the new RDA. Christian was nominated to be Policy Coordinator.
